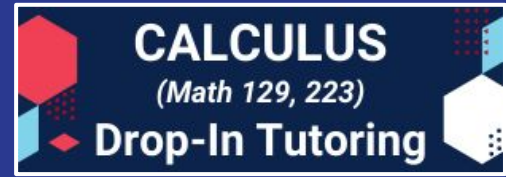

1. Click the **Calculus Drop-In Tutoring** widget/button on your class D2L homepage.
2. **Sign-in** with your **UA NetID login**
3. Click "**Join**" to request access to the MATH-Tutoring team.

  - *After you've been approved once, you won't need to request access again.*

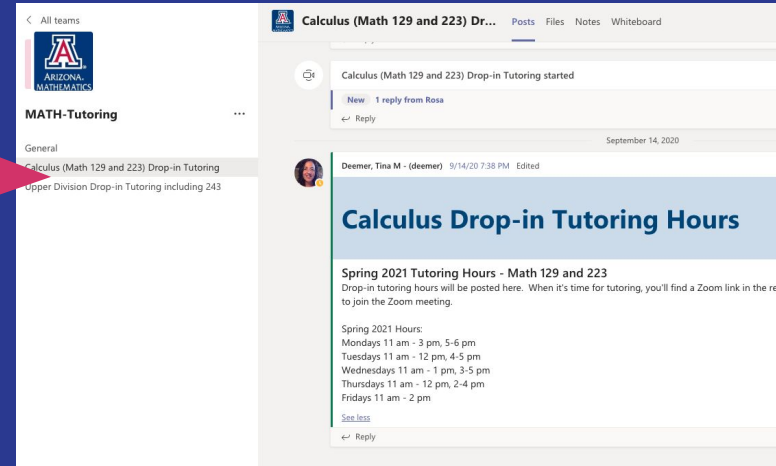

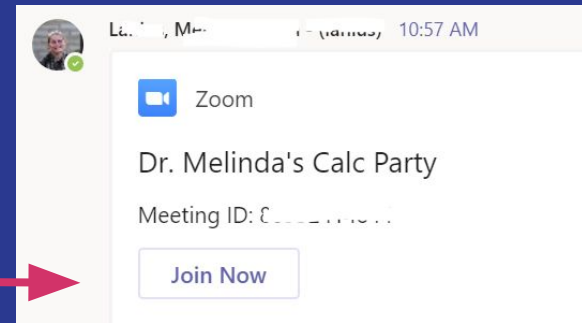
# How do you join Online Tutoring? *cont.*
