

Advising Students to Enroll by “My Requirements”

An exciting new feature is available to students for registration for Fall 2011! Enroll by “My Requirements” allows students to view a more user friendly version of the online advisement report that only shows course requirements and only displays courses that are being offered in the enrollment term the student selected. This narrows the student’s course selection to courses that are actually being offered that term and shortens the advisement report considerably for ease of making enrollment decisions.

One of the other benefits to the Enroll by My Requirements feature is that it will display ALL courses that are being offered in the enrollment term, not just those that are approved/active courses as of the current date. The regular online advisement report that advisors and students access in self-service only displays current, active courses.

This is particularly important to note because of the recent update to Tier One General Education courses. All of these courses are newly approved beginning 08/01/2011 for the Fall 2011 term, therefore they do not yet show up on the online advisement report. The new courses display on the pdf version and, because they are scheduled for Fall 2011, they display on the Enroll by My Requirements report for Fall 2011. It is strongly encouraged that students use the Enroll by My Requirements feature to select courses for their Fall 2011 shopping cart.
